A combination of few button presses including the home button will be the first step to the factory data resetting process. But if there are no physical volume buttons, the process may be quite different from the normal tablets. Only after booting your Android tablet into recovery mode, you will be able to hard reset Android tablet without volume buttons. To know how to reset an Android tablet without volume buttons, follow the steps described below. Remember that this method would only work if your Android device has a home button. Step 1: Press Power off + home button Press the power button until the options for Power off, Restart, and others appear. Now, tap on the "Power off" option and hold on to it while pressing the home button of your The android device at the same time. Step 2: Confirm boot into safe mode Now, the screen for rebooting into safe mode will appear. Tap on "Yes" to enter the safe mode. Step 3: Enter recovery mode Press and hold the power button as well as the home button of your device simultaneously until a new screen appears. After it appears, release the two buttons and press the power button one more time. Now, press and hold down the home button. With that, you will enter into recovery mode and a new set of options will appear on the screen. Step 4: Navigate and do Factory Reset Using the home button to navigate, move down to the "Wipe data/factory reset" option. Press the power button to select the option. You may have to confirm your choice by selecting "Yes". Step 5: Reboot your device After the reset is complete, navigate to the "reboot system now" option and select it to reboot your device. At the end of this process, your device will be reset. An LG800G phone that refuses to turn on might be recoverable if you can kickstart the device and perform a hard reset. Hard resets, also known as factory resets, are a last-ditch effort method of recovering a cellular phone that's in a non-functioning or problematic operational state. The LG800G must be turned on in order to activate the hard reset command; removing as many things that could be stopping the phone from powering on may help return the phone to a state where you can reset it. Slide the back case of the LG800G off by pressing on the lip around the camera and pushing toward the bottom of the phone until the cover becomes unhinged and you can lift it off. Remove the battery by prying it out from the bottom edge to expose the SIM card slot and the microSD card slot. Slide the SIM out from the phone's SIM slot, remove the microSD card if one is installed, reinsert the battery, and then slide the back cover back into place. Plug the USB charger into the phone and connect the charger to an active power outlet. Press and hold the power on button for about 30 seconds to a minute to force a battery restart. If the phone turns on and works correctly at this point, skip to Step 12. Press the "Menu" icon in the lower right cover of the main screen once the phone has loaded, Touch "Settings," tap the "Phone" option, and then select the "Reset Settings" option. Select "Master Reset" from the reset options list. Press the "Yes" option when the phone prompts you with the reminder "All Settings will be reset." Enter your 4-digit security code, and then press "OK." If you never set a security code, the phone's default is either "0000" or "1234". Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the factory reset process. Power the phone down once the phone has completed the reset process. Slide the back cover off the device again and remove the battery. Reinsert the SIM card and reinstall the microSD card if you previously had one installed. Troubleshooting FAQ This could be because your battery has died. The DOPO m975 has a rechargeable battery inside it, and a charging port on the outside. Try plugging your tablet into the charger, waiting a few minutes, and trying again. Sometimes tablets slow down, freeze and need to be reset. The fastest way to reset a M975 is by simultaneously depressing the power button and the home button for about 10 seconds. Once an Android screen appears, use the volume up/down buttons and select "factory reset", then depress the power button to select. Touch screens for various devices need to be recalibrated. Make sure that your tablet's touch screen sensors are properly calibrated. Go to settings --> Accessibility --> Touch Panel Calibration to recalibrate. If this still doesn't help, see question 4 for directions on resetting your tablet, because your tablet will be automatically re-calibrated upon restart. Factory resets can sometimes wipe a tablet. If your data is not backed up, see below. Press and hold the power button for about 15 seconds to force the tablet to shut down. Buttons can come loose/unhinged on the inside of the device Try taking a needle and inserting it under the lock button itself to unstick it. # If this does not work, unscrew the tablet and separate the back of the tablet from the front/screen. Then, adjust the position of the lock button itself with tweezers. Screw the tablet back together. Chargers can break from time to time, but before you run out and get a new charger - the charger port might be compromised. There could be dust in the charging port. With a can of aerosol dust spray, spray it into the charging port, to clean it out. If this does not work, the wires in your charger may be starting to come loose. Adjust the position of the charger in the port, and try again! If all else fails, order a new charger from here.
